England Golf Trust PING Prodigy G Junior Golf Set

Are the clubs being given to me?

- No. The clubs will be lent to you until you grow out of them or you decide not to continue playing golf. Then they must be returned.
- As the clubs are on loan, you must not sell them or give them to anyone else. You must not alter or customise them.
- When you have grown out of the clubs, or if you decide not to continue playing golf, they must be returned.
- You must look after the clubs and keep them safe at all times.

Do I have to tell you how I am getting on with the clubs?

- England Golf Trust would like to keep in touch with you to find out how you are getting on, and you may be asked to write regular updates and provide photos. If you agree, we may share your progress and experiences on our website, social media and with PING to inspire others.
- In your application, you will be asked to demonstrate your commitment to golf and how the clubs would make a difference to you. If it appears that you have not been able to become as committed to golf as you had expected or if you have decided not to continue playing, England Golf Trust and PING will ask you to return the clubs so they can be passed on to another junior golfer.

What happens if I grow and the clubs are too small?

- The clubs are designed to be adjusted as you grow. If you get in touch with PING, they will do the adjustments for you. You must not adjust or modify them yourself, or ask anyone else to do it for you.

What happens if my clubs are lost, stolen or damaged?

- You must look after your clubs and keep them safe at all times. If any or all of them are lost or stolen, you must let England Golf Trust and PING know.
- PING may be able to provide a replacement club or clubs, but this cannot be guaranteed.
- If you damage one of your clubs when you are playing with it, you should contact PING who may be able to repair or replace it, but this cannot be guaranteed.

What if I decide to give up golf?

- The clubs must be returned. You must contact England Golf Trust to let us know so we can arrange for them to be passed on to someone else.
